



Requirements



Tested browsers are Chrome, Firefox and Safari



MetaMask installed (don't use any other wallet extensions!)



BNB tokens in your account to swap back from remote chain¹ to Sirius Chain

¹remote chain = Binance Smart Chain (chains other than Sirius Chain)

Important information

- → This document and swap utilizes main networks

- → Binance Smart Chain note that we only have **TWO** contract addresses for BSC:
 - ◆ XPX contract address:

◆ MetX contract address:

0x16365c943364c5493c9B10F35aA7f3E153450155





Install MetaMask

- → Install MetaMask on your browser: https://metamask.io/download
- → In this example, Chrome is used as a browser. If another browser is used, the flow should be almost the same



→ To use an existing MetaMask wallet, you can choose to import one. Otherwise, create a wallet (click on Create a Wallet)




- → Click on "I Agree"
- → Type in a password twice
- → Mark the checkbox
- → Click on "Create"
- → Click on "Next"
- → Click on "CLICK HERE TO REVEAL SECRET WORDS"
- → Write down the 12 words and store them in a secure place²
- → Click on "Next"
- → Confirm the Backup Phrase (tick them in the right order)
- → Click "Confirm" followed by "All Done"


²It is strongly recommended that you do not write this in notepad or on a loose sheet of paper as the 12 words cannot be recovered once lost

Configure MetaMask for Binance Smart Chain


→ Go to Settings



- → Click on "Networks"
- → Click on "Add Network"
- → Use these settings:
 - ♦ Network name: BSC Mainnet
 - ◆ New RPC URL: https://bsc-dataseed.binance.org
 - ♦ Chain ID: 56
 - ◆ Currency Symbol: BNB
 - ♦ Block Explorer URL: https://www.bscscan.com
- → Click on "Save"



→ Click on "Import Tokens"




- → Paste the contract address: 0x6F3AAf802F57D045efDD2AC9c06d8879305542aF
- → Click on "Add Custom Token"
- → Click on "Import Tokens"
- → Repeat the same for MetX with the following contract address: 0x16365c943364c5493c9B10F35aA7f3E153450155


Using your wallet to swap from Sirius Chain

If you have a private key or your wallet a wallet backup file, and your wallet is new, you import that private key or wallet backup file into your new wallet by following the instructions below:

- → Open your wallet (web wallet) using this link: https://web-wallet.xpxsirius.io/
- → Click "Create a new Sirius Wallet" as shown in the figure below:




→ Click "From a Private Key" or "From a Wallet Backup" as shown in the figure below:



Follow the instructions till you are complete with importing the private key or the wallet backup

Swapping assets

Now that your wallet is in place, open it and log onto the wallet. You should be able to see the swap function on the left-hand frame as shown in the figure below:



→ Click on the "Swap" tab


→ You should be able to select from the swap utility three options as shown below:

Swap from Binance Smart Chain to Sirius Chain


→ Select BSC to Sirius Chain if you are swapping from BEP20 BSC to Sirius Chain as shown below:



- → If you are not connected to Metamask yet:
 - Click on "Connect to MetaMask"
 - ◆ Check the account details and URL and click on "Connect"
- → You have two options at the moment to swap over from the BSC chain, i.e., either XPX or MetX
- → Fill in the MetaMask address you are swapping from
- → Key in the amount of XPX or MetX to swap and then click on "Send Request"
- → To swap from Binance Smart Chain back to Sirius Chain, you'll need BNB!
- → Sign off the transaction in MetaMask to approve the transaction by clicking on the "Confirm" button. Please note that there are fees involved in the transaction and it will be added onto your transaction
- → Follow the instructions and keep a record of your transaction. You are now finished with a swap from th BSC to the Sirius Chain

Swap from Sirius Chain to Binance Smart Chain

→ Click on "Sirius Chain to BSC" option and you will come to the page below:



- → Choose either MetX or XPX as shown in the figure
- → Enter the MetaMask address that you want to swap your Sirius Chain asset into
- → Select the fee on the BSC network that you wish to spend. The BSC optional fee structure allows for faster confirmation times
- → Once completed, click on "Confirm Swap"
- → Follow the instructions and keep record of your transaction. You are now finished with a swap from teh Sirius Chain to the BSC Chain

Possible Problems

Problem:
MetaMask doesn't connect
Possible solutions:
→ Refresh your browser (Ctrl+F5)
→ Reinstall MetaMask
Problem:
When swapping from Binance Smart Chain to Sirius Chain, the following error is
shown: "Please select BSC Mainnet on Metamask to swap"
Solution:
Select the "BSC Mainnet" in MetaMask
Problem:
Am I able to speed up a transaction in MetaMask?
Solution:
No, your swap wouldn't be successful
Problem:
My balance in MetaMask isn't updated, but I can see the new balance on the explore
Solution:
Use another endpoint (change the node), for BSC you can change to one of these BS

Problem:

When I try to swap to the Sirius Network, why can't I connect my Metamask wallet when I click "Connect to MetaMask" but instead another wallet pops up for me to sign in?

Solution:

You may have other crypto wallets that are installed as extensions. The browser cannot determine which wallet it can attach to. Please switch them off by going to the "Manage Extensions" at the top right of the browser and deactivate them. (Note: not remove but deactivate the slider). Leave MetaMask activated.
